- On the Register Your Device page enter your UNI and its password, then select Log In. TIP: your UNI account is the same one used for Student Information Systems or myColumbia.
- 4. Select the link to **Start** or **Install QuickConnect**.
- 5. Follow web browser prompts to save and open QuickConnect.
 - If it doesn't open automatically, browse to the downloaded QuickConnect file and double-click on it.
 - If you see a protection or security warning, click **More info** or follow any prompts to allow the ArubaQuickConnect program to run.
- 6. Click Next in the CUMC ClearPass Onboard Wizard window.
 - If Security Warnings to install a certificate appear, select **Yes** to allow.
- 7. ClearPass will run, then display a success message. Click **Finish**.
- 8. The web browser will show a **Device provisioning complete** message. You can close the browser, set up has successfully finished.
